

USE OF YOUR NAME AND BILLING ADDRESS

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has directed all local phone companies to provide a subscriber's billing name and address (BNA) data, upon request, to long distance carriers when:

- A subscriber uses a Local Exchange Carrier (LEC) joint calling card
- Accepts a third number call or collect call
- Places a 1010XXX call from an equal access office

BNA information will be provided to interexchange carriers who require a billing name and address to bill a phone call. Such disclosure may be used for billing purpose only and cannot be employed for any other use by service providers

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Should you not want your name and billing information shared with any long distance carrier, please use the below form:

This is to advise you that my Billing Name and Address information is not to be released to anyone for any purpose.

I understand that I will not be able to place third number calls or telephone company joint use calling card calls and I will not be able to receive collect call on my phone.
