# How to Setup the Basic Functions of Your Voice Mail

The first time you access your voice mail, you may want to setup a custom voice mail greeting. A standard greeting is the default.

### Before You Begin:

Lift the handset and press \* 9 9 to access your voice mail.

## **Setup Your Voice Mail Greeting:**

- 1 Press ( to access the setup menu.
- 2 Press 1 for greeting options.
- 3 Press 4 to record a greeting.
- 4 Record your greeting and press # .
- 5 Press 1 to play your greeting.
- 6 Press 2 to keep your customized greeting.
- 7 Press \* to return to the setup menu.
- 8 Press \* to return to the main menu.

Group Greetings for multiple mailboxes are available. Please dial 777 or 1-866-279-2161 to have these advanced features activated.

Your Voice Mailbox has Auto Log-in enabled by default, which means that when you retrieve your voice mail from home, you do not need to enter your password. Your **Default Password is 0000**. We recommend that you change your password for your security.

### To Change Your Password:

- 1 Lift the handset and Press \* WXY 99 WXY
- 2 Press to access the setup menu.
- 3 Press 2 to change your password.
- 4 Enter your new password, followed by # . A password is any series of up to 16 digits you choose. You will need your password to access your mailbox when you are away from home.
- To verify, enter your password again, followed by 📕 .
- 6 You will be returned to the setup menu or Press \* for the main menu.

**Should You Disable Auto Log-in?** Auto Log-in allows you to use your voice mail at home without a password. If you wish to access your voice mail at home with a password you must disable the auto log-in feature.

- 1 Lift the handset and Press \* 9 9
- 2 Press to access the setup menu.
- 3 Press 4 for auto log-in options (a recording will say auto log-in is now enabled).
- 4 Press 1 to disable auto log-in.
- 5 Press \* to return to setup menu.
- 6 Press \* to return to main menu.

## Listening and Responding to Messages

Retrieving from home – Lift the handset and Press \* "g" g"

Retrieving from a remote location – Dial your home phone number, Press \*when you hear your voice mail greeting. Enter your password and Press #.

## When Listening to Your Messages:

Press 1 to play.

Press 2 to save and play next.

Press [3] to delete and play next.

Press to save as new.

Press 5 to return this call.

Press to forward to another mailbox.

Press 7 to skip back.

Press (8) to pause or continue.

Press to skip forward.

Press \* to return to the main menu.

Press 0 to hear the instructions again.

Callers will receive a busy message greeting letting them know you are home but currently on the phone. This feature also works with Call Waiting.

**Message Delivery** 

Now when someone leaves you a voice mail, they have the option to mark the message as normal or urgent. If a message is marked urgent, it will play before any other messages when you log in to your voice mail.

### Voice Mail to e-mail

Now you can receive your voice mail via e-mail. Simply open your e-mail message, listen to the audio file and save it on the hard drive, forward it to other e-mail addresses or delete it.

To setup this feature on your account, call Golden West.

### Call Return

Simply Press after listening to a message and automatically return the call. No longer do you need to try to remember a phone number. This feature is available for most local and long distance calls.

### Forwarding a Message

Press 6 to forward the message you are listening to. Enter a list of mailboxes (10-digit phone numbers) separated by # . Please end the list with # # . (e.g. 605-555-1212#605-555-2121##)

Messages can only be forwarded to local phone numbers. The number you are forwarding to must have voice mail to receive the message.
